Annex D

Rangeland Management

1. Obligations of Concessionaire of Dedicated Rangeland Lot:

A Concessionaire of Project Site with a dedicated Rangeland lot (as designated by the Concessions Authority) shall have the following additional obligations regarding such Rangeland:

- i. Not to resort to or allow cutting of palatable vegetation and lopping of trees;
- ii. Improve and develop the Rangeland for the desirable kind of livestock by improving the ratio and growth of palatable species;
- iii. Developing water drinking points and ponds;
- iv. Making ridges for water spreading;
- v. Ensuring sustainable grazing and avoiding overgrazing;
- vi. Prefer and allow grazing of the desirable kind of livestock of local people instead of the livestock from outside the district in which the Project Site is located; and
- vii. Bind the grazers and owners to take care of the needs of livestock for additional fodder, feed, disease control and selection of appropriate breeds of the desirable livestock.

2. Obligations of Concessionaire of Mixed Plant-able Area Lot with Rangeland:

A Concessionaire of Project Site of a mixed plant-able area with Rangeland lot (as designated by the Concessions Authority) shall have the following additional obligations regarding such Rangeland:

- i. Not to resort to or allow cutting of palatable vegetation and lopping of trees;
- ii. Not to graze or allow grazing of livestock in the range area of the lot. Provided, gathering of forage for feeding outside is permissible;
- iii. Improve and develop the Rangeland for the desirable kind of livestock by improving the ratio and growth of palatable species;
- iv. Developing water drinking points and ponds;
- v. Making ridges for water spreading; and
- vi. Ensuring sustainable grazing and avoiding overgrazing.
